With respect to All Full-time and Part-time Active Employees of St. Joseph's Hospital Health Center who are defined as program B1 and B2 employees who are managers, directors, vice presidents, senior officers or advanced practice clinicians, the **Eligible Class(es) For Coverage** provision shown in the **Schedule of Insurance** section of the **Long Term Disability** portion of Your certificate is amended to read as follows:

Eligible Class(es) For Coverage: All Full-time and Part-time Active Employees of St. Joseph's Hospital Health Center who are defined as program B1 and B2 employees who are managers, directors, vice presidents, senior officers or advanced practice clinicians, who are on U.S. payroll or are citizens or legal residents of the United States, its territories and protectorates; excluding temporary, leased or seasonal employees. Also excluding the following:

- 1) any individual who has been classified by the Employer as an independent contractor, notwithstanding a contrary determination by any court or governmental agency,
- 2) nonresident aliens with no income from sources within the United States,
- 3) "self-employed individuals" under Code Section 401(c); and
- 4) union employees who are members of a collective bargaining unit that has bargained in good faith over benefits substantially similar to those available under the Plan and whose participation is not provided for under such agreement.

Employment: at least 20 budgeted hours per week.

In all other respects the certificate remains the same.
