#### **Updated Safety Guidance at <RHM>**

Your safety is a top priority for <RHM>. We continue to follow Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and other public health authority guidance for safety requirements in our locations. We updated our requirements to follow the CDC's recently updated guidelines, which are based on how many COVID-19 cases are spreading in our community.

Here are highlights so you know what to expect the next time you visit <RHM>:

• Masking may be required if COVID is spreading at a high rate in our community.

For everyone's safety, all visitors, patients, and colleagues are required to wear masks in our facilities when the <a href="COVID-19">COVID-19</a> community transmission rate is high in our area, as reported by the CDC. This rate changes from time to time, so plan to bring a surgical or KN95-style face covering every time you visit <RHM>. Cloth masks, vented and gaiter-style face coverings are not acceptable.

If you have any COVID-related symptoms, you must always wear a mask when inside our facilities.

All colleagues are required to be masked when the <u>COVID-19 community transmission rate is high</u>, except in some colleagues-only areas of our facility at certain COVID community levels.

 Masking may be optional for patients, visitors, and colleagues if COVID is spreading in our community at a moderate or low rate.

If the <u>COVID-19 community transmission rate</u> is not high in our area, masking is optional for patients, visitors, and colleagues – except for certain designated areas of the facility. These areas will have signage indicating where universal masking is required. If you are immunocompromised, you are encouraged to wear a mask at all times at <RHM> for optimal protection.
